

OREGON COAST MARINE EXPERIMENT STATION ADVISORY COUNCIL
CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I - NAME, LOCATION

The name of this organization shall be the Oregon Coast Marine Experiment Station Advisory Council, and its headquarters shall be at the office of its Executive Secretary.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose of this Council shall be: Represent the marine agricultural interests related to agriculture of the Oregon coast and related waterways, advise the Oregon Coast Marine Experiment Station of the Agricultural Experiment Station of Oregon State University, with particular reference to research programs and facilities, priorities, and resources, and generally the ways in which the Station can better serve marine-related agriculture on the Oregon coast.

ARTICLE III - FINANCE

There shall be no membership fees, assessments or dues levied or collected, nor shall there be any expenditures by or for the account of this Council.

ARTICLE IV - LIABILITY



ARTICLE V - AMENDMENTS


This constitution may be amended by a vote of three-fourths of the membership in accord with the terms of the By-Laws regarding meetings and voting.
